CRITERIA/GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR THE TEACHERS APPLYING TO APPEAR IN LOCAL SCREENING BOARD INTERVIEW MAR 2025

Clearing of Combined Screening Test/Online Screening Test,

- 1. Combined Screening Test (CSB)/Online Screening Test (OST) Score Card Holder with pass percentage as applicable in the passing year.
- 2. Passing the Online Screening Test is not mandatory for appearing for the interview and evaluation of teaching skills & computer proficiency. **However, OST qualified candidates will be preferred.** Non OST qualified candidates after selection to the post of a teacher (regular & fixed term), must pass the OST as per details given below failing which their appt will be terminated (the same will be endorsed in the appointment letter of non OST qualified teacher appointments):-
 - (a) Regular Appointment Candidates. Within two years of being appointed with a minimum overall raw score of 50% (100 marks).
 - (b) <u>Fixed Term Appointment Candidates</u>. Within one year of being appointed with a minimum overall raw score of 40% (80 marks).

Note. All score cards issued till date are valid for life.

3. Candidates seeking appointment for teaching subjects for which Online Screening Test was not conducted are also eligible for which the school has advertised the posts.

Passing of CTET/STET

CTET/TET conducted by State Govts is mandatory for TGTs (minimum 60% marks).

Note 1.

- (i) In addition to the minimum aggregate percentage mentioned in the table above, a candidate should have scored no less than 50% marks in each of the subjects in which they have graduated/ post- graduated. Detailed mark sheets will be scrutinized during the interview.
- (ii) *A Post-Graduate with less than 50% aggregate marks in Graduation can also apply for the post of a TGT / PRT, provided the candidate has scored a minimum of 50% or more aggregate marks in Post-Graduation.
- (c) CTET / TET conducted by Centre / State government is **mandatory for appointment as TGTs/PRTs** in the REGULAR and FIXED TERM category. Candidates who have not qualified CTET/TET but found fit in all other aspects may be considered for appointment on vacancies which may be ADHOC in nature.
- (d) Aggregate percentage will be based on the marks for the entire duration of Graduation/Post Graduation.
- (c) No specific academic qualification is laid down for activity teachers. Their selection will be subject to suitability based on experience and knowledge as assessed by the Board. Good communication skills in English is mandatory.
